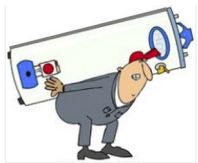

Who We Are

SAFE is a 501c3 nonprofit charity.

SAFE is a 100% volunteer nonprofit.

.Every dollar of government grants directly benefits very low income seniors.

SAFE relies on donations to cover operating costs which are less than 4%.

Who We Help

SAFE is focused on providing assistance to elderly residents who qualify under the Federal and State guidelines of extremely low income and acutely low income. Emphasis is placed on those with the following attributes:

1. Extremely & acutely low income
2. Below poverty level as defined by Federal and State guidelines
3. Disabled and within the guidelines above and Veterans.

Our primary beneficiaries are women, who were systematically denied income opportunities due to the customs of their generation and veterans who sacrificed their income-earning years to serve their country.

Many are from the “Greatest Generation” who struggled to provide following generations with so much more than they enjoyed.

While most civilizations take care of their elderly, our planning agencies wonder “Where can we warehouse the old people?”

SAFE’s mission is to allow this fiercely independent, yet grossly underserved, generation to remain in their homes and maintain their dignity. They deserve our

How We Help

SAFE has distributed over \$1,000,000 in Federal and private grants for major maintenance items benefiting its target demographic. Items include new roofing, HVAC systems, electrical repairs, and energy-efficient windows. Such repairs are well beyond the means of these seniors. The result is that they are able to remain living independently in their homes without the fear of homelessness.

Donations are used to buy materials and supplies for our volunteers to perform smaller home repairs and improvements. We also partner with other nonprofits and businesses to leverage contributions.

SAFE also provides medical equipment to its members and information and resources relevant to seniors 62 and over.
